

Sixth Form Entry Requirements (last years)

Pathway 1: 4 A-Levels	8 GCSEs/Level 2 BTEC at 5/Merit grade (to include an English and Maths) + individual course requirements
Pathway 2: 3 A-Levels	6 GCSEs/Level 2 at 5/Merit grade (to include an English and Maths) + individual course requirements
Pathway 3: BTEC Extended Diploma	6 GCSEs/Level 2 at 4/Pass grade (to include an English and Maths) + individual course requirements

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to achieve a grade 7 in either of their combined science examinations, regardless of which route they have followed. Students studying separate sciences are required to achieve a grade 7 in GCSE Physics. We also require students to have gained a grade 7 in Mathematics and ideally be looking to follow the A-Level Mathematics course.
