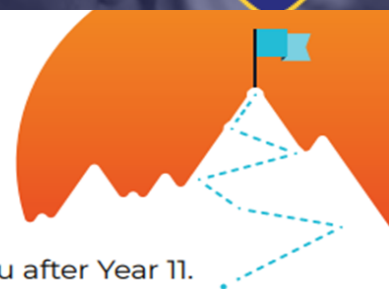

For your students aged 14-18 who may be considering careers in medicine, we've 2 courses coming up that may interest them.

The first course is an online course, taking place every Monday evening in January from 7.30pm - 9.30pm. Students tune in to watch our doctors explain all about careers in medicine and work through some interesting medical cases with them. The second course takes place over the February 16th- 18th weekend and is our popular in person course in London. Students can expect to shadow doctors and get hands on with some fantastic work experience complete with accommodation, meals and supervision. As the UCAS deadline for NHS Health Careers is in January, the sooner students begin work experience, the better. I kindly request your assistance in sharing these details with your students.

Only two Live work experience sessions remain before the UCAS January deadline for all Allied Healthcare university courses. These universities mandate work experience in a caring or service role within health or related fields, including direct observation of healthcare. Acquiring such work experience can be challenging, and there are areas that students may be interested in but cannot explore. Once they've registered, students will be emailed links to their virtual work experience portals. Please ask students to check their spam folders and mark their attendance on the day in order to receive their Work Experience Certificates.

During the work experience day, students will follow 2 patients from their initial presentation to recovery. They will gain a unique insight into how patients interact with a variety of healthcare professionals and what it's like to work in an NHS multidisciplinary team. Attendees will have the opportunity to interact with healthcare professionals throughout each day. This will empower students to make an informed career decision and demonstrate their commitment to healthcare in their UCAS applications. Students can register individually at any time throughout the 6-month programme using the link below. We recommend booking early to gain as much out of this programme as possible. Places are £10 a session to cover administrative and technological costs.

Who can apply?

This programme is aimed at those in the later years of full-time secondary, sixth form or college education who are keen to get an introduction to what a career in financial services may be like.

The Work Experience programme is delivered each Summer. Specific details regarding each opportunity are available when you apply.

To be considered for the programme, you will:

Be in full-time education either at secondary school, sixth form or college at the time of the work experience commencing keen and motivated to find out more about HSBC and to be prepared to complete the application process, which will include an online assessment and if successful, a telephone interview.

UK Work Experience Programme
