

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

To make the most of your visit, we recommend planning ahead. Here are some things to think about before your open day:


- Sign up in advance

- Visit the Students' Union pick up free stuff!


• Visit stands on things like finance and study abroad. Make the most of the opportunity to ask questions








Subject Taster Days


