Medic Summer School via Medic Mentor

We have the last couple of weeks for students to apply for **free places on our summer school** (we usually have from 30-50 free places). The application deadline is 5pm on 28th February 2024. This is for students in Y12. Students need to apply here <https://airtable.com/appcb33sgzK8sgn1O/shrZ8Hh8kyr4vasp9>.

The summer school is brilliant, <https://medicmentor.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/06/UK-Summer-School-Booklet.pdf>. Students receive extensive support from Medical Students to help write the perfect Personal Statement, followed by 1 full day of interview practice. Students also receive 5 weeks of daily virtual UCAT teaching (an excellent UCAT score is crucial to getting a Medical School offer in the UK, especially now as BMAT is no longer being used)

Students will also get:

- Virtual interview days with Doctors and 1-to-1 interview training sessions before each of their university interviews
- Automatic enrolment in the Medical Awards Programme and the Medical Leadership Programme to strengthen university applications
- Help with strategically choosing universities to maximise chances of receiving an offer
- A reference written by a doctor to help guide the teacher's reference
- Access to E-Learning resources for Wider Reading

It is really competitive, so I recommend students sign up for our free sessions (such as our Get into Medicine and Dentistry Conferences, Societies and Wider Reading clubs) to have the best chance when applying.
